CALL FOR AUTHORS TO WRITE BOOKS FOR CENJOWS

Guidelines

- 1. The book draft should be submitted in British English with a word count of 50,000 words, not including references. Font Size 12, Font Style Arial, 1.5 Spacing and Chicago Style Referencing are mandatory.
- 2. The book draft must not have been previously published or under current consideration elsewhere.
- 3. The book submission should be accompanied with the following contents in a singleword file
 - Title of the Book
 - Foreword
 - Preface
 - List of Figures, Tables & Boxes and List of Abbreviations
 - Introduction
 - No of Chapters
 - Conclusion
 - Endnotes
 - Index
- 4. Brief CV of the author (not more than 150 words).
- 5. The draft of the book should be emailed to <u>cenjows@cenjows.in</u> with 'Submission for publication of Book' appended in the subject line. The draft sent by any other means will not be accepted.
- 6. If the draft of the book is found plagiarised or the use of any AI content, it will be deemed invalid.

- 7. Since CENJOWS is a non-partisan think tank of the HQ IDS, no political, religious, or ideologically motivated text is acceptable.
- 8. The Screening Committee reserves the right to cancel the submitted draft if it does not comply with the given guidelines.
- 9. The author should provide his bank account details for the honorarium, which include:
 - Account holder's name
 - Account number
 - IFSC Code
 - Branch name

An appropriate Honorarium will be paid for the book after peer review. This will be discussed with the author.
